DATA LINK never far back, raced three wide around the far turn, swung out for the stretch run and rallied under a hand ride to be up late.

JOES BLAZING AARON chased GLOBAL POWER around the first turn after being outrun for the lead, moved up on the backstretch to engage that rival, vied for the lead into the stretch, edged to a clear lead but couldn't resist the winner late. BEAU CHOIX reserved early, advanced along the rail down the backstretch to reach contention, then finished willingly along the rail to be up for the show. ZA APPROVAL rated off the pace, advanced into contention down the backstretch, angled out for the stretch run while rallying to loom a threat in midstretch, then was weakening when steadied late. EMPIRE BUILDER failed to menace. GLOBAL POWER outran JOES BLAZING AARON early, responded when challenged by that rival on the backstretch, vied with that one along the rail to the top of the stretch, then tired. HOWE GREAT chased the pace, made a run three wide to join the leaders racing down the backstretch, remained in contention to nearing the stretch and faltered. CASH RULES was not a factor. SCATMAN reserved early, rushed up four wide down the backstretch to reach contention, then faded. NIGHT PARTY allowed to settle, rushed up on the backstretch to reach contention briefly, then had nothing left.
