NOT FOR SILVER dropped well back after being steadied soon after the start, saved ground to nearing the stretch, swung out for the drive and rallied to take over inside the eighth pole, then drew away. **YOU LUCKIE MANN** unhurried after breaking slowly, rallied to reach contention in the stretch but was no match for the winner while gaining the place. **PRINCE JOSHUA** vied for the lead along the rail to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. **ASK JOE** reserved racing along the inside, tired in the drive. **WALL STREET WONDER** stumbled at the start, vied for the lead outside **PRINCE JOSHUA** to the eighth pole, then faltered. **TRUEST LEGEND** showed brief speed three wide and faded.
