By subscription of \$400 each which should accompany the nominations; \$2,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$4,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the the publication of weights. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, March 21, 2015 with 19 Nominations. (Clear 54)

DADS CAPS tracked the pace along the inside, got set down spinning just off the inside into upper stretch and was bumped and leaned on by PALACE straightened away, rallied to issue a challenge a furlong out drifting slightly under a near sided stick half a path between foes before seizing command inside the final furlong, inched away in the late stages to prevail. GREEN GRATTO broke out at the start and was corrected, set a solid pace from the two path as others opted to ease off in the early going, shifted to the rail midway on the turn, got let out cutting the corner into upper stretch coming under challenge from a pair to the outside, dug in gamely fending off the assault to the eighth pole before being displaced inside that station, battled on inside to procure the place honors in a good effort. DREAM SATURDAY chased the pace four to five wide put to encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, cornered five wide into upper stretch, rallied to threaten for it all a furlong out, battled on to the wire but was outfinished in the late stages. THE BIG BEAST just off the pace just off the inside, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled six wide into upper stretch, kicked on with mild late foot for the last major share. PALACE broke well and was eased off to race three wide in close aim of the leader, remained patiently handled until set down swinging three wide into upper stretch, came in straightened away bumping and leaning on DADS CAPS, then weakened in the final furlong. WILD DUDE chased the pace four then three wide under encouragement from the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. CLEARLY NOW bobbed at the start getting away slowly and conceding three lengths to the front, chased in the overland route from towards the rear, advanced steadily midway on the turn moving into striking range before swinging six to seven wide for home, couldn't sustain the mild momentum and tired in the stretch. STREET SHARK a bit fractious in the gate, chased three wide forwardly placed very early on, lost ground into the turn and shifted to the rail with seven-sixteenths to run before giving way.
