EMPIRE WAY also pulled early, chased off the inside on the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and six wide into the stretch and put in a late bid. BLINGO bumped between horses at the start, raced unhurried off the rail, came out into the stretch and was outfinished. HANDSOME MIKE had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and until past midstretch and weakened late. COZZETTI stalked the pace three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DRILL had good early speed and dueled outside a rival then between foes, put a head in front on the second turn, fought back alongside HANDSOME MIKE into the stretch and between horses again in midstretch and weakened. MAJESTIC CITY stalked outside then bid three deep to press the pace, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in and weakened. BASMATI pulled his way between horses to stalk the pace, fell back some on the second turn, angled inward in the stretch and also weakened. DESORMAIS unhurried and angled in off the rail early, trailed off the inside, found the fence on the second turn and was not a threat. GROOVIN' SOLO bumped early and again nearing the first turn as the rein broke into that turn,
