MAJOR MARVEL was away alertly to procure a stalking position two wide in the clear, drew closer on the far turn and at the top of the lane, drove past and edged clear inside the final furlong. NORTH STAR BOY (IRE) settled off the pace mid-pack early on, went four wide around the first turn, edged closer into the far turn, launched a strong bid four wide into the top of the lane but weakened late. BEST ACTOR raced inside till upper stretch at which point the rider angled him out three wide to continue his rally, captured show honors but just missed the place. POLITICAL COURAGE raced unhurried toward the rear while between runners two wide, began to pick up steam into the lane from that inside position, angled five wide at the eighth pole and closed fast but had too much to do. GRIP HANDS bobbled at the break, saved ground but was blocked and forced to wait through upper stretch. BLAMESHIFTER secured stalking position while being caught four wide on the first turn, bid five wide on the far turn, flattened out late. EL UNO was back early, swung seven wide on the far turn, passed tired rivals. PLAINVIEW set the pace, gave way. ALL KNIGHT was far back early, swung eight wide into the lane, showed some gain. DAYS RIDE stalked the early leaders three wide, weakened midway on the turn and through the stretch. DR. CHASE was four wide on the first turn and six wide on the far turn, had no rally. DR.
