FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE STARTED FOR A CLAIMING PRICE OF \$7,500 OR LESS SINCE JANUARY 1, 2010. \$50,000 guaranteed, of which \$27,500 to first, \$10,000 to second, \$5,000 to third, \$2,500 to fourth, and \$500 to all other finishers. WEIGHT: Three Year Olds - 117 lbs. Older - 124 lbs. Fillies and Mares allowed 5 lbs. Non-winners of three races for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$10,000 or greater since January 1, 2010, allowed 2 lbs.; of two races for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$8,000 or greater since January 1, 2010, allowed 4 lbs.; of a race for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$8,000 or greater since January 1, 2010, allowed 6 lbs. In the event that two or more horses have the same point totals for a pre-entree race, selection priority will be determined by the tie breaker rules set forth by the Claiming Crown Ltd. PEDROLINO went two to three wide on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, rallied three to four wide on the far turn, surged to the lead near the five-sixteenths pole, inched clear coming to the quarter-pole, accelerated further clear in upper stretch and drew away under urging then was eased up late. **SEVERE WEATHER** settled on the inside, was urged along on the backstretch, angled four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, steadied while caught behind **INDIAN WEAVER** at the top of the stretch, moved a bit to the outside and safely secured the place. **BUILT TO PRECISION** showed good speed, raced off the rail on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, lost the lead near the five-sixteenths pole and tired while best of the rest. **BABY AFLEET** saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, went three then four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide near the five-sixteenths pole, briefly tipped out to six wide then dropped back to five wide near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. **MAJHOOD** broke a bit slow, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back between rivals coming to the quarter-pole and failed to respond. **LAMBEAU** showed early speed between rivals, went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased inside on the far turn and came up empty. **INDIAN WEAVER** was caught four wide on the first turn, raced up close on the outside, chased two to three wide on the far turn, drifted four wide outside the quarter-pole and faded.
