POINT FINISH pressed the pace two wide, ratcheted up the pressure into the far turn, took control of the race heading into the lane and quickly drew clear under steady urging. FRANCOIS raced three wide on both turns, was second best. TOH'S GREY CAT benefited from an inside trip, improved position, finished evenly. WHATTHECATDRUGIN was hard used early to get the lead and angle to the rail prior to entering the first turn, set a moderately pressured pace racing inside, gave way in the lane. FROGGYVILLE was unhurried early racing off the pace, moved up between runners two to three wide down the backstretch, angled to the rail at about the quarter pole, couldn't gain any further through the lane. IN RHYTHM was bumped at the start and settled toward the rear early, raced inside while steadily advancing down the backstretch, shifted out midway on the far turn, was four wide into the lane and continued to improve position throughout. BROTHER BIRD made a middle move up between runners on the backstretch, faltered, faded. FLATTERMEJIM was bumped at the start and raced toward the rear early on, swung six wide on the far turn, passed tired rivals through the stretch. RED HILLS chased inside while close early, steadily retreated. HORNED FROG was caught four wide around the first turn, raced in the second half of the field while wide, went five wide on the far turn, had no late bid. DEPUTIFORMER saved ground racing inside, weakened. ROMAN'S AVENUE was four wide on the turns, never factored. TYLER'S WILDCAT chased three wide while close early, dropped back, faded. HE'S SPECTACULAR dwelt at the start and spotted the field about three lengths, trailed throughout.
