**5 FURLONGS. (Turf) (.552) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 CHURCHILL DOWNSTURF SPRINT S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD.** By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three year olds 118 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice on the turf since September 7, allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 on the turf in 2010, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off of the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Wednesday, April 7, 2010 with 31 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs.). (Clear 76)

SILVER TIMBER within striking distance, advanced three wide late on the turn and closed well to be up in time. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE close up early, steadied once in the turn when BARGE drifted out a bit, recovered, advanced four wide into the stretch and rallied willingly late to be steadily gaining. CENTRAL CITY vied for the lead off the inside, took over with a furlong to go and held on gamely. FORMIDABLE outprinted early, commenced his rally off the inside on the turn, angled out a bit for the drive and closed well. MORALIST close up along the inside, angled out near the sixteenth marker when rallying and made a late gain. STARFISH BAY alternated for the lead off the inside and tired late. BARGE with the early pace between rivals, dropped back a bit and drifted out with three furlongs to go then weakened. PERFECT OFFICER outrun early, angled out four wide entering the stretch and could not threaten after angling back in a bit. MITIGATION outrun early, came five wide into the stretch and could not menace. HEAVENLY CHORUS was outrun. LIT'SGOODLOOKNGGRAY trailed.
