GYPSY ROBIN sped to a clear early lead, angled in and set all the pace a bit off the rail and held on gamely under some urging with the whip turned down and steady handling. MADAME CACTUS a bit slow to begin, saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside on the turn and into the stretch to loom a threat and continued willingly but could not catch the winner. WEDNESDAY close up stalking the winner a bit off the rail, came out in upper stretch and just held third. CURVY CAT between horses early, settled off the rail, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed the show. BIG HONEY BEE stalked outside a rival then off the rail leaving the backstretch, was between horses leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked a rally. GIVINE (FR) chased outside a rival, dropped back a bit off the rail on the turn, angled to the inside in the stretch and weakened.
