7 FURLONGS. (1.21) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 CHICAGO H. (GRADE III) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination. A Supplementary Nomination of \$3,000 may be made on Saturday, June 22, 2013, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. **WEIGHTS:** Sunday, June 23, 2013. This event will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Highweights preferred. Total earnings in 2013 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees with the exception of the nominating fee(s). Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations Closed Wednesday, June 19, 2013 with 19. (Cloudy 70)

COZZE UP LADY was rated in hand tracking the pace behind the second flight while angling to the rail in the opening stages, continued unhurried inside foes racing into the turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, switched out entering the lane with an abrupt move to challenge four deep between foes and produced a solid late response to prevail in time under firm handling. QUEEN'S AWARD tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, made a steady advance to contention three deep nearing upper stretch, moved to challenge for command leaving the furlong marker, struck the front between calls late but was just outkicked. AUBBY K settled between foes off the second flight in the opening stages, was urged along to advance racing four wide through the turn to upper stretch and was making mild progress between foes in that path to the end while failing to match the top pair. MAUDE S settled outside a rival in the last flight racing to the turn, steadily drew into contention while shifting out five wide splitting foes racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. FLOWER SPELL broke through the gate prior to the start, sprinted clear of the field from the break while angling inside, maintained a clear advantage to upper stretch but faltered leaving the furlong marker. DRAMA DRAMA settled inside a rival along the rail in the opening quarter, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch gathering momentum, was urged to advance four wide racing into upper stretch, was steadied out of tight quarters when losing her path to the eventual winner nearing the three sixteenths marker, then continued evenly between foes to the end. DR. DIAMONDS PRIZE worked her way to the inside early tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing into the turn but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. LA SONG chased the pacesetter racing into the turn a bit off the rail and came up empty racing into upper stretch after failing to gain terms with the leader. LADY CHESTERFIELD settled outside foes in the opening stages, was caught five wide racing through the turn and soon dropped out.
