FLOWER SPELL broke sharply to establish a clear advantage, dictated the pace racing off the rail into the bend while increasing her margin, was roused to maintain that advantage racing into upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. DISCO BARBIE tracked the pace five deep as part of

the second flight in the opening stages, continued in that path racing into the bend and finished with interest between foes late to edge rivals for a share. ALLANAH, off last, settled into stride off the inside racing to the turn, angled out six wide in upper stretch and continued with a belated response to gain some position. EDEN PRAIRIE gained a forward placing tracking the pacesetter while leading the second flight under

light rating racing between foes in the opening stages, angled to the rail racing into the turn while losing some ground to the pacesetter and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. FIRE TRICKS was settled in the last flight along the inside early, saved ground to upper stretch while gaining some position but made no real impression. COZZE UP LADY tracked the pacesetter as part of the second flight inside foes early, shifted out nearing the turn while being urged to advance between foes but retreated approaching upper stretch. QUEEN'S AWARD was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. CHORTLE tracked the leaders four deep between foes as part of the
