KODIAK KOWBOY settled in good position while saving ground, was trapped along the inside through the turn, altered course to the outside to get clear in upper stretch and finished determinedly to get up in the final seventy yards. BRIBON (FR) lunged a bit at the start, raced in good position just behind the leaders in the two path, lodged a bid from outside at the quarter pole, surged to the front a furlong out, battled into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. VINEYARD HAVEN dueled in the two path into midstretch, fought gamely into deep stretch and was narrowly edged for the place. VACATION was reserved for five furlongs, ranged up three wide to reach contention at the quarter pole and flattened out. PYRO checked at the start, trailed while saving ground for six furlongs and lacked a late response. DRIVEN BY SUCCESS dueled along the rail for six furlongs and gave way.
