the final three jumps. SECRET CIRCLE drifted inward after stumbling at the break, carrying inward a total of three rivals for a brief period, was taken hold and put back on a truer course, got guided onto the inside, kept an eye on the winner, was put to solid urging after going halfway around the bend, vacated the inside route in upper stretch, failed to cut into the top one's margin then just held the place. BOURBON

COURAGE took up the chase from the two path, was sent over to the rail past the five-sixteenths marker, cut the corner into the stretch, closed readily to improve position, altered course further to the outside coming to the sixteenth pole, kicked in with good belated energy, but missed the place. BIG BUSINESS settled into midpack, was strung out in the three path at the midway point on the turn, swung slighter wider into the stretch, moved wider yet in reaction to the antics coming from VYJACK while travelling through the furlong grounds, mustered up a mild second place finisher, took up the chase from the two path, got put to a hard, prolonged drive on the turn, wandered into the six path during the

response thereafter to grab the final major check. VYJACK was carried in a bit shortly after the start, due to pressure originating from the opening stages of the stretch run, after some left handed stick work, lacked the needed response. NOBLE MOON raced sluggishly down the chute, was in the two path during the run around the bend, fanned into the eight path from upper to midstretch, went on to mainly improve position. REGALLY READY underwent a three wide pursuit, was through after completing three-quarters. TRANSPARENT was pushed slightly towards the inside after stumbling at the start, raced four wide on the turn, failed to reach a contending position. ITSMYLUCKYDAY brushed a few strides after the start, saved ground to upper stretch, failed to pick up interest despite being put to some encouragement while still on the chute, backed away after turning for home to complete a dull effort.
