JERANIMO chased inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, bid five wide in midstretch, gained the lead, drifted in and drew clear under a strong hand ride while being shown the whip. WAR ELEMENT broke a bit slowly, moved up three deep into the first turn, stalked three wide on the backstretch, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch, bid four wide then between horses in midstretch, could not match the winner but gamely edged foes for the place. CALIMONCO saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside in the stretch to put a head in front, fought back in deep stretch and held third. JOHN JOHNY JAK stalked outside a rival then between horses, bid three deep into the stretch and between foes in midstretch and was outfinished for a minor award. LEROY'S DYNAMEAUX settled inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and finished with interest. BOB BLACK JACK sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, inched clear again on the second turn, fought back between horses in midstretch and weakened some late, was unsaddled into the clubhouse turn and vanned off. MAKE MUSIC FOR ME settled outside then off the rail, went three deep into the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. BUENOS DIAS (IRE) allowed to settle just off the rail then outside a rival, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ASSESSMENT stalked the pace a bit off the rail, bid alongside the leader into the second turn, tracked that one between horses on that turn, fell back into the stretch and weakened.
