About 1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.42) STAKES. Purse \$125,000 COL. E.R. BRADLEY H. (GRADE III) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$125 by Saturday, January 5. \$600 to enter; \$625 additional to start. Supplemental nominations will be accepted by 12.00 noon, Thursday, January 10 at a fee of \$3,000 which shall include entry and starting fees. \$125,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second, 10%, to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Weights: Thursday January 10. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. The maximum number of starters for the Col. E. R. Bradley Handicap will be determined by rail setting. High weights on the scale will be preferred. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, January 5, 2013, with 26 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth.) (Rail at 25 feet). (Cloudy 70)

Bay Colt, (Mar), by English Channel - Indy Pick by A.P. Indy. Trainer Lukas Wayne D.. Bred by Bluegrass Hall, LLC(KY).

OPTIMIZER went to the front, set the pace through moderate fractions, drew clear when set down in upper stretch and proved much the best under strong urging. STRING KING settled on the inside, moved closer late on the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn, eased off the rail while under a drive in upper stretch and secured the place. BIM BAM saved ground on the first turn, was reserved under a tight hold at the back, went two then three wide on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and got up for the show. UNLATCH went three wide on the first turn, raced just off the pace on the outside, chased three then four wide on the far turn, drifted out a bit near the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. TREND went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and lacked the needed response. STRIKE IMPACT tracked the pace, chased two to three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, vied into upper stretch then gave way. DUBIOUS MISS went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn, advanced into a good striking range on the outside but came up empty. TETRADRACHM was hard held while eager and three wide on the first turn, raced between rivals while under restraint on the backstretch, went three then two wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. JAMES STREET settled off the pace, dropped back on the far turn and faded. (Rail at 25 Feet)
