THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. Closed Saturday, December 29, 2007, with 20 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and 1/16.). (Clear 55)

FRENCH BERET settled off the rail while close up, moved up three wide around the second turn, bid outside the leaders in upper stretch, got clear and then proved best while kept to the task. MAJOR RHYTHM settled inside from early on, rallied down the lane and gout up for second. STERWINS between foes much of the trip, showed late interest. SAVE BIG MONEY set a pressured pace, was displaced before mid stretch and then held on well. STORM TREASURE devoid speed until midway around the second turn, was steered out turning for home and closed mildly. SIDCUP raced wide and could make little impact. SILVERFOOT well back much of the trip, lacked the needed finish. GOLD SOUND (FR) raced inside to the second turn, moved out before the drive and then had no late response. OPTIMER (ARG) forced the pace outside SAVE BIG MONEY until the drive and then faltered inside the final furlong.
