1 1/4 MILES. (1.404) STAKES. Purse \$750,000 *FITZ DIXON COTILLION S. (GRADE II) FOR FILLIES THREE YEAR OLDS*. By subscription of \$750 each which should accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to pass the entry box, \$2,000 additional to start, with \$750,000 guaranteed. The purse to be distributed: \$7,500 to all starters with the balance of the purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Winners of a grade I race at a mile or over in 2009 to carry 2 lbs. additional. Non-winners of a graded race at a mile or over in 2009 allowed 3 lbs. of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2009, 5 lbs.; of three races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming in 2009, 8 lbs. This race will not be divided. A field of 14 horses will be drawn with the preference given to Graded/Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III), stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Tuesday, September 29, 2009. Nominations closed Saturday, September 19, 2009 with 13. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. (Cloudy 77)

CARELESS JEWEL drifted out while drawing clear early, moved four wide while clear on the first turn, was straightened out and maintained her advantage off the inside, drifted out again near the quarter pole and was never threatened while kept to pressure in the final furlong. BON JOVI GIRL dropped back early, moved between foes after a half mile, advanced into the stretch then went evenly in the final furlong. KEY LIME BABY saved ground throughout, moved closer on the final turn, and continued well in a good effort while never threatening the winner. JUST JENDA advanced between rivals before half a mile, was fanned very wide into the stretch and continued to weaken. CAT MOVES pursued the pacesetter near the inside, was hard ridden to keep pace on the final turn then weakened between rivals in the stretch. MARY'S FOLLIES chased the pace outside to the final turn then faltered.
