A supplemental nomination fee of \$650 may be made by closing time of entries; \$300 to pass the entry box and an additional \$350 to start. All entrants will be required to pay entry and starting fees. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winner of \$35,000 at a mile or over other than restricted stake allowed 2 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, December 18, 2010 with 36 Nominations. (Cloudy 50)

MONZON was taken in hand twice and pulled off ARTHUR'S TALE to avoid contract at the break, dove to take up residence along the inside, bided time from there, being unasked for speed, closed a lengthy gap from the competition after leaving the half mile pole, with the rider still keeping something in reserve all the while, fanned four wide into the stretch, gained readily on the front runner during the run through the furlong grounds, wrested the lead away from J J'S LUCKY TRAIN departing the sixteenth pole and edged clear under a light drive. J J'S LUCKY TRAIN three wide around the opening bend, settled into the two path upon reaching the backstretch, kept a watchful eye on the pacesetter, moved when ready nearing the quarter pole, forged to the front after an abbreviated duel, attempted to stave off the top one as that foe drew alongside with about a sixteenth to go, wasn't up to the task, but continued onward with good courage to garner place honors. PANTS ON FIRE was rated under a good hold while setting the pace along the inside, was put to the test nearing the end of the run around the second bend, offered resistance until approaching the eighth pole and weakened. ARTHUR'S TALE within range for nearly six furlongs, was put to a prolonged drive but could make no headway on the front runners. TAP STAR saved ground, fought against the bit early before acting more professionally leaving the opening turn, was called upon for a response midway on the far turn and tired. RUSH NOW bobbed at the start, was floated out into the four path on the first turn by J J'S LUCKY TRAIN, settled a bit closer to the inside down the backstretch, kept pace three wide under some coaxing until the quarter pole and gave way.
