JUSTIN PHILLIP outrun in the early going, asked for some run late in the turn, came four wide into the stretch, closed with good mettle to be in time. PICKO'S PRIDE broke alertly, set or forced the pace while racing off the inside, continued to duel turn, disposed of the other speed, past the furlong marker, gave ground grudgingly to the winner late. GENTLEMEN'S BET moved up soon after the start to duel inside the runner up, unable to match strides with that foe the final furlong while also unable to contain the winner, saved the show in the final strides. LAURIE'S ROCKET in the second flight while racing off the inside, came three wide into the lane, slowly gaining for the show while not a danger to the top two. OUTTA TUNE last away, raced back, continued to trail, moved out widest for the drive, displayed some mild, belated interest. FLASHPOINT behind pace well off the inside, four wide out of the turn, lacked serious kick. AMANECER DE ORO back off the pace, floated out five wide entering the stretch, failed to muster a late bid. APPREHENDER shortened stride soon after the start, pulled up, vanned off.
