SMILING TIGER tossed head, off step slow, moved out a bit while back, came five wide when beginning to advance out of the turn, roused once right handed, full of late run to win going away with something left. SILVER MAGNUS in hand early, moved up outside the leader while still under restraint through the turn, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, proved no match for the winner the final seventy yards, held well for the place. CHIEF OF AFFAIRS broke alertly, soon got clear onto the main track, showed the way into the turn, dueled through the bend closest to the inside, weakened a bit drive while just off the rail, narrowly held the show. NATIVE RULER back off the pace, saved ground through the turn, displayed a modest amount of late interest up the rail to miss the show. RILEY TUCKER lacked speed inside, asked along into the turn, displayed little in the way of a response in the drive. HOLYFIELD forwardly placed early off the inside, retreated down the lane.
