

7 FURLONGS. (1.22³) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 CHARLES TOWN OAKS FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. Free nominations close Saturday, September 7, 2013. \$1,500 to enter, with a purse of \$400,000 guaranteed. Supplemental nominations of \$20,000 will be accepted at time of entry, which includes all fees. Horses having won a North American, European or Asian graded or group stakes will have \$1,500 of their entry or supplemental fee refunded upon starting. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing seventh through last, 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stake in 2013 allowed 3 lbs., non-winners of sweepstakes since June 1, allowed 5 lbs. Field will be limited to ten starters with up to four alternates. Preference to North American, European, and Asian graded or group stakes winners in order(Grade 1, then Grade 2, then Grade 3), then to highest earnings in North American, European, and Asian graded and group stakes, then to the highest lifetime earnings. Entries close Wednesday, September 18 by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. (Showery 68)

Bay Filly, (Apr), by Sightseeing - Happy Scene by Dehere. Trainer Amoss M. Thomas. Bred by John R. Penn & John C. Penn(PA). SO MANY WAYS, steadied when pinched back leaving the starting gate, raced in the three path between horses the first turn, ranged up four deep on the far turn, took the lead near the sixteenth pole then edged away. R FREE ROLL, angled to the two path approaching the first turn, took the lead outside JAX AND JILL leaving the backstretch, opened a clear advantage on the final turn and tired the final sixteenth of a mile. MR HALL'S OPUS lacked speed, circled the far turn four deep and rallied. BLUEEYESINTHEREIN, angled to the three path entering the first turn, moved up in the three path between horses on the far turn and failed to sustain her bid. AWESOME MAMA worked her way over to the two path approaching the first turn, chased the pace while remaining in the second lane and weakened late. ILE ST. MOLLY lacked speed, failed to be a serious factor and was vanned off. GOLD EDGE lacked speed and was not a factor. JAX AND JILL accelerated to the early lead, angled to the inner rail entering the first turn, remained along the rail and gave way turning for home. THETALOVEANDMINE, four wide the first turn, was outrun and circled the far turn three deep.
