1 MILE. (Turf) (1.312) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 DANIA BEACH S. FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Saturday, December 3, 2011, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$60,000, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth and \$2,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry at a fee of \$5,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes at a mile or over, 4 lbs., two races other than maiden or claiming 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, December 3, 2011 with 4 8 Nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 48 feet). (Clear 70)

Bay Colt, (May), by War Front - Rose of Summer by El Prado (IRE). Trainer Clement Christophe. Bred by Graceville Breeding(KY). SUMMER FRONT stumbled badly at the start, stalked the pace three wide, eased out and rallied to take over at the sixteenth pole, then edged away. FINALE chased the pace three wide, made a run to reach near even terms for command in the stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner while edging EXCAPER for the place. EXCAPER prompted the pace outside CSABA, made a run to contest the lead in midstretch, then weakened. COALPORT reserved early, raced three wide around the far turn and closed ground late. CSABA set the pace along the rail to inside the sixteenth pole, then gave way. EMPIRE BUILDER stalked the pace along the rail into the stretch but had no late response. ITALO unhurried after being steadied in the early going, saved ground, angled out for the stretch run and gained some ground without threatening. BURNING TIME saved ground and failed to menace. BROTHER PAT tracked the pace along the inside into the far turn and tired. VEE ONE ROTATE was not a factor. STARFORCE raced four wide and faltered.
