held place honors in deep stretch. PLEUVEN (FR) held up in rear through the early going, advanced on the far turn racing on or just off the rail, still trailed at the top of the lane, was angled to the five path in upper stretch and willingly launched a rally once in the clear but was left with too much to do. YES I'M LUCKY was away alertly and secured inside position but was taken back and guided outside a foe into the first turn, attended the pace on the flank of that one, made a bid in upper stretch but weakened late. IMAGINETHATMOM settled toward the rear early

rail in upper stretch, drew clear. CABO CAT was content to settle off the pace racing outside a foe early, began to pick up the pace when asked heading into the far turn where he advanced three to four wide, swung five wide into the lane to continue the prolonged rally, captured and then

racing inside to midway on the far turn at which point he commenced a rally, shifted out four wide for running room, angled out further to the six path in upper stretch to continue the bid but couldn't sustain it and flattened out late while improving position. HERE'S JOHNNY raced two to three wide throughout while stalking the pace between runners early, was still in contention at the top of the lane but weakened in deep stretch. HESINFRONT went three wide around the first turn, moved up to stalk the pace four wide down the backstretch but steadily retreated after the

half. BON ACCORD stumbled at the start and rushed to clear the field and set the pace under moderate pressure, gave way in the lane. REQUEST tracked along the inside, had no late response.
