BERN IDENTITY was hustled from the gate, moved up inside of KING HENRY and poked a head in front after a quarter pole, battled through fast fractions with that one while under hand urging, edged away a bit past the three sixteenths marker, kept on under a strong drive and went clear at the wire. KING HENRY sped to the early lead while three wide, ceded the advantage near the half mile marker, dueled three wide around the turn and into the lane, battled valiantly to the wire and narrowly maintained the place. TRICKMEISTER broke alertly then settled in a perfect spot stalking the top pair, edged closer three wide and under rousing into the stretch, came in briefly when asked right handed, shifted back out from behind KING HENRY leaving the three sixteenths marker, closed under left handed encouragement and drifted out late. PERILOUS INDIAN broke a step slow, recovered and edged closer while saving ground mid turn, angled three wide for the drive but needed more late. LEMON DROP DREAM, off the rail, was put to the whip leaving the three eighths pole, angled four wide and lacked a rally. VEGAS NO SHOW settled back early after coming away in decent fashion, dropped towards the rail, came under pressure mid turn, swung wide into the lane and had belated action.
