NOW I KNOW set a well handled pace from the start, drew off on the far turn then was kept to task in late stretch. INNY MINNIE stalked the pace while racing on the inside, saved ground on the backstretch and far turn, rallied on the inside making a bid then held the place safe in the end. YVETE SANGALO (MEX) was unhurried early on then started a run heading into the far turn, rallied three wide in the stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch but missed the place in the end. DEVIOUS INTENT was allowed to settle while racing two wide on the backstretch, made a bid into the far turn but was no menace in late stretch. DELIGHTFUL MAGIC stalked the pace while inside, made a bid on the far turn then gave way in the stretch. CULOTTE was allowed to settle while being kept to the inside, saved ground on the far turn then failed to menace in the stretch. GOSPEL GAL was unhurried early then was four wide in the stretch but no threat in the end. YEARDLEY was four wide on the run down the backstretch, was hard used and faltered in the stretch. CANDREA was stalking the pace while racing three wide, made a bid on the far turn to mid stretch then stopped suddenly and was eased up at the wire. CITIZEN ADVOCATE was through after a half then stopped and was distance in the stretch.
