break, was taken to rate early, advanced between rivals mid turn, negotiated his between rivals in the lane and closed willingly towards the inside. CRAFTY SCHEMER set a pressured pace along the inside, was headed leaving the eighth pole and weakened late. MACH SPEED

saved ground around the turn and lacked a solid bid. CELTIC INNIS chased the pace while off the rail, angled out six wide for the drive and flattened out. ATTILA'S STORM disputed the pace between rivals, bumped with COPPERTONE KID nearing the turn, steadied when in tight

leaving the three sixteenths marker when the winner drifted in then faded. JOEY CARSON came in at the break bothering NIGHTTIME

AFFAIR, lacked speed, raced well wide in the drive and failed to menace. COPPERTONE KID disputed the pace three wide, bumped with

ATTILA'S STORM entering the turn, continued to battle to the head of the lane, tired and was not abused.
