THOR'S ECHO stalked a contested pace outside, rallied four to five wide into the lane, drifted in a bit nearing the furlong marker, took command near the sixteenth pole and dug in under a drive. DIABOLICAL raced close up along the rail and under rating, angled out five wide in upper stretch, closed gamely outside of the winner but wasn't quite good enough. NIGHTMARE AFFAIR steadied when in tight soon after the break, was taken to rate early, advanced between rivals mid turn, negotiated his between rivals in the lane and closed willingly towards the inside. CRAFTY SCHEMER set a pressured pace along the inside, was headed leaving the eighth pole and weakened late. MACH SPEED saved ground around the turn and lacked a solid bid. CELTIC INNIS chased the pace while off the rail, angled out six wide for the drive and flattened out. ATTILA'S STORM disputed the pace between rivals, bumped with COPPERTONE KID nearing the turn, steadied when in tight leaving the three sixteenths marker when the winner drifted in then faded. JOEY CARSON came in at the break bothering NIGHTTIME AFFAIR, lacked speed, raced well wide in the drive and failed to menace. COPPERTONE KID disputed the pace three wide, bumped with ATTILA'S STORM entering the turn, continued to battle to the head of the lane, tired and was not abused.
