BIG JOHN B chased inside or outside a rival, moved up between foes three deep into the final turn, bid outside the leader into the stretch to gain the lead and won clear under a left handed tap of the whip and strong handling. BENCH LIGHT settled outside a rival, split horses into the last turn, was in a bit tight into the stretch, split foes, came out and gained the place. BRIGHT THOUGHT dueled between horses then re-bid between foes past the wire the first time, stalked on the backstretch then inside on the final turn, came out in the stretch and was edged for second. STARSPANGLED HEAT chased outside a rival then three wide, went four wide into the final turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. UNBRIDLED COMMAND angled in and chased inside then came out in the stretch the first time, bid three deep to duel for the lead, kicked clear and angled in on the backstretch, battled inside the winner into the stretch and weakened. POSHSKY came off the rail on the middle turn, went up four wide into the last turn, angled in leaving that turn and lacked the necessary response in the stretch. SI SAGE (FR) had speed outside foes then inched away and angled in, dueled inside, then stalked along the rail, split horses into the last turn then steadied sharply in tight on that turn and weakened. FIRE WITH FIRE pulled and was in a bit tight passing the wire the first time, chased outside a rival or between horses, continued just off the rail leaving the last turn and also weakened. TOPIC saved ground off the pace, had the saddle slip on the backstretch then had the rider lose the irons and was not persevered with in the lane. COGITO dueled three deep then inched away and angled in, battled inside past the first wire and on the middle turn, stalked inside on the backstretch, dropped back into the
