1 $\frac{1}{2}$  MILES. (Turf) (2.12) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 DEL MAR H. (GRADE II) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$3,000 additional to start, with \$200,000 Guaranteed, of which \$120,000 to first, \$40,000 to second, \$24,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$4,000 to fifth h. The Del Mar Handicap has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge Races. The nominated winner of the Del Mar Handicap will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2011 running of the Breeders' Cup Turf. The nominated win ner will also be entitled to have pre-entry and entry fees waived (\$90,000 value) for the Championship race, and will be entitled to receive a travel stipend of \$10,000 (US) if traveling from a location in North America or \$20,000 (US) if traveling intern ationally. To be eligible for the 2011 Breeders' Cup Championships to be held at Churchill Downson November 4 and 5, 2011, all horses must be pre-entered by noon (Eastern time at the designated pre-entry locations) by October 24, 2011. Winner must be nomin ated by pre-entry deadline to receive Challenge rewards. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday, August 18, 2011 with 16. (Rail at 14 feet). (Clear 80)

CELTC NEW YEAR three deep on the first turn, angled to the inside in the stretch the first time, saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, gained the advantage, inched away briefly in midstretch, fought back when challenged and held on gamely between foes late under urging. BOURBON BAY bumped at the start, stalked the pace off the rail then outside a rival, was briefly between horses on the backstretch, continued alongside a foe on the final turn, came out four wide into the stretch, bid alongside the winner past midstretch and went willingly to the wire to just miss three deep on the line. IMPONENTE PURSE (BRZ) angled in and chased inside, came a bit off the rail on the last turn, split horses in midstretch then bid inside in deep stretch and also went gamely to the end. MAKE MUSIC FOR ME pulled on the early lead, set the pace inside then surrendered the advantage on the backstretch, came off the rail on the last turn stalking the leader, angled three deep between horses into the stretch and weakened late. SOUL CANDY chased inside, came out into the backstretch, went up three deep to gain the lead, angled in and showed the way along the rail, fought back into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. MEDICI CODE (GB) bumped at the start, settled inside then chased a bit off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and also weakened.
