DISPOSABLEPLEASURE stumbled badly at the start, recovered and was quickly guided over to the rail, judiciously took the inside route around the opening bend, remained along the inside biding time down the backstretch, angled outward sharply into the four path leaving the seven-sixteenths pole, pushing BOURBONSTREETGIRL five wide while being steadied, and forcing another pair in the vicinity, both CAPTIVATING LASS and DREAMING OF CARA to be steadied likewise, with the latter seeking refuge momentarily along the overland route, was under a snug hold approaching the quarter pole, responded immediately when released from it, readily splitting rivals coming to the three-sixteenths pole, forged to the front at the eighth pole, dug in gamely from there to stave off the runner up at the conclusion of their stretch duel. WILDCAT'S SMILE under a firm hold wedged in tight between rivals, was allowed to ease back, rated kindly two wide in midpack until the five-sixteenths pole, was let out a notch and moved into the three path in preparation for the stretch run, bid from there turning for home, left the eighth pole only a sliver behind the winner, tried valiantly from there to the wire, but got denied. BOURBONSTREETGIRL reserved from off the inside, was impeded and pushed five wide by the top one midway on the turn, remained well off the inside for the remainder of the run around the far turn, closed in well making her way to midstretch to loom a threat, but could not sustain the move. WEE PARTY went quickly to the lead, showed the way from the inside, pressed by at least another pair until the quarter pole, was put to heavy pressure entering the lane, remained a prominent factor for an additional eighth, then weakened. BROWN EYED NANCE forwardly placed for three-quarters, had no rally. LADY COHIBA strung out three wide on the first turn, accompanied her stable mate a bit closer to the inside after entering the backstretch, kept up the pressure until midstretch before backing away. CAPTIVATING LASS sat reserved from off the inside, commenced the run around the far turn three wide, was forced to steady coming to the three-eighths pole when bothered, failed to pick up any real interest thereafter. DREAMING OF CARA unhurried from off the inside during the opening stages, was steadied and forced onto the overland route in reaction to the winner's move in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole. AWALKINTHEMOONLITE failed to menace. INDYNIABLE four wide until approaching the half mile pole, folded. An objection lodged by the rider of BOURBONSTREET against the rider of DISPOSABLEPLEASURE
