CONDO COMMANDO away in good order and alertly, was under a firm hold while establishing control, made it over to the rail by the end of the homestretch, responded well to the rating hold by utilized by the pilot, cut the initial fractions with ANGELA RENEE in attendance from the two path, at times hitched up and at other times not, began to kick away after going three-quarters, was almost at the three-sixteenths pole before asked for run, gave it readily, had built up an imposing lead when geared down in the final seventy yards. CALAMITY KATE sat loosely pocketed, started getting asked for more and more from around the seven-sixteenths marker until called upon a furlong later, angled three wide into the stretch, lost contact steadily with the top one but won the fight for the place. ANGELA RENEE assumed a forward position after departing the starting gate, was coaxed along accompanying the winner while taking the two path, got set down turning for home after having been shaken off, was outfinished for place honors. QUEZON bumped right after the start, chased the winner two to three wide on both turns, lacked the necessary stretch response. SAVE ROCK AND ROLL lightly bumped from both sides just after springing forth from the gate, saved ground to the quarter pole, failed to respond when asked to coming to the three-eighths pole. GAP YEAR bumped a short distance after the start, raced three wide to the quarter pole, gave way. MY CARA MIA off the inside, swung five wide into the stretch, had little left to offer and backed away.
