MACHEN settled in hand off of the inside, split rivals and shifted out to commence his rally entering the turn, was bumped between horses near the five-sixteenths pole and carried out, came six wide, finished with a surge and was up in the final strides. DOMINUS was away alertly, disputed the pace to the outside of TRAVELIN MAN, shook off that one and opened clear with a furlong to run, kept on well but was turned away in the shadow of the wire. J J'S LUCKY TRAIN was rank to place between horses, fought restrain for five furlongs, angled out bumping MACHEN with five-sixteenths to run, was straightened away and continued on willingly to earn the show. INDIAN WINTER settled in hand, ranged up four wide to make a mild bid leaving the turn but failed to sustain the drive. INDIANO tracked the pace three wide through the turn, angled in entering the stretch but weakened in the drive. TRAVELIN MAN disputed the pace along the inside to the final furlong and faded. BEAMER broke awkwardly and was slow into stride, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. B G SUAVECITO was hung wide, was bumped and carried out with five-sixteenths to run and showed little thereafter. DUCA contended along the inside through the turn and dropped out.
