INCLUDE ME OUT stalked outside a rival then between horses on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up, took a short lead past the eighth pole and proved best under a tap with the whip turned down and a mild hand ride then a long hold late. SHUMOOS sped to the early lead off the inside, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, bumped with TEDDY'S PROMISE into the stretch, fought back off the fence through the final furlong and continued willingly between rivals late. TEDDY'S PROMISE pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside, steadied into the turn, went up inside leaving the turn, bumped with the runner-up and steadied sharply into the stretch, continued inside and went on willingly along the rail late. CONKATE chased outside then alongside a rival, went three deep leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. WINDING WAY close up stalking the pace outside a rival, was between horses into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong. VIA VILLAGGIO chased a bit off the rail then inside on the backstretch and turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and did not rally. SELF PRESERVATION saved ground off the pace, came a bit off the rail on the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked a further response. A claim of foul by the rider of TEDDY'S PROMISE against the runner-up for alleged interference into the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled there was never enough room for the former to get through.
