HAYNESFIELD pressed the pace in hand for a half, moved between horses on the far turn, took the lead nearing the quarter pole, lugged in slightly after opening a clear advantage in midstretch then drew away under left hand urging in the late stages. BAD ACTION raced in hand along the rail for six furlongs, swung three wide leaving the quarter pole and closed steadily from outside to edge GONE ASTRAY for the place. GONE ASTRAY settled just off the pace in the three path for six furlongs, edged a bit closer to threaten nearing the quarter pole then lacked a strong closing response. REDDING COLLIERY rushed up along the rail to gain the early advantage, set the pace in hand on the backstretch, led to the turn and gradually tired thereafter. BIRD RUN stumbled badly at the start and trailed throughout.
