MI SUENO between horses early, chased outside a rival, split foes three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead four wide in deep stretch and prevailed. BLIND LUCK a bit slow to begin and bumped in the early stages, settled inside, came out

on the turn and five wide into the stretch, drifted inward some in midstretch but finished well. LA NEZ chased outside then alongside a rival, moved up four wide leaving the turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage three deep in midstretch, was between horses in deep stretch and just held third. IT TIZ stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch, split rivals in midstretch then rallied between foes in deep stretch and was edged for the show. REPO between foes early, stalked inside, came out into the stretch, bid between rivals in midstretch and continued willingly but was outfinished. NECESSARY EVIL bumped after the start, went up inside to duel for the lead, took the advantage nearing the turn, inched away into the stretch, fought back along the rail in midstretch and weakened late. PUNCTUAL sped to the early lead
