along the inside, kicked away in the stretch and held on gamely but was edged on the line. MECHAYA stalked outside a rival then between foes on the turn, continued a bit off the rail into the stretch and bested the others. MISS EMPIRE a bit slow to begin, settled inside or a bit off the rail, continued inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HEIR KITTY also broke a bit slowly, was allowed to settle toward the inside then just off the fence on the turn, swung out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. RENEE'S TITAN chased off the inside then between foes, dropped back between horses on the turn and weakened. PAT'S BACK pulled her way along

to stalk the pace inside then a bit off the fence, angled back to the inside on the turn and weakened in the stretch. WASTED AT MIDNIGHT

pulled between horses then chased outside a rival, went three deep on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch.
