By subscription of \$300 each, on or before June 1, 2012, the fee to accompany the nomination. All horses shall pay \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$3,500 additional to start, with \$300,000 Guaranteed, of which \$180,000 to first, \$60,000 to second, \$36,000 to third, \$18,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. . Weight 122 lbs.; Non-winners of \$50,000 allowed 2 lbs.; of a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; of a race other than claiming, 6 lbs.; A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Friday, June 1, 2012 with 194. (Clear 79)

EXECUTIVEPRIVILEGE stalked four wide then three deep on the backstretch and turn and into the stretch, drifted out some in the drive but rallied under urging to get up on the wire. BEHOLDER hit the side of the gate at the start, sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace along the inside, kicked away in the stretch and held on gamely but was edged on the line. MECHAYA stalked outside a rival then between foes on the turn, continued a bit off the rail into the stretch and bested the others. MISS EMPIRE a bit slow to begin, settled inside or a bit off the rail, continued inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HEIR KITTY also broke a bit slowly, was allowed to settle toward the inside then just off the fence on the turn, swung out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. RENEE'S TITAN chased off the inside then between foes, dropped back between horses on the turn and weakened. PAT'S BACK pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside then a bit off the fence, angled back to the inside on the turn and weakened in the stretch. WASTED AT MIDNIGHT pulled between horses then chased outside a rival, went three deep on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch.
