RENDEZVOUS bumped and steadied in tight in the chute, saved ground off the pace, split horses into the second turn, continued a bit off

the rail, came out past midstretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up on the wire. BATTLE OF HASTINGS (GB) pulled between horses early then stalked three deep, continued outside on the second turn and three wide into the stretch, gained the advantage under urging

outside a rival in deep stretch, drifted in some and continued willingly but was caught on the line. ACCLAMATION had speed outside foes then angled in and set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and second turn, inched away again into the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the drive, fought back in the final furlong and held third. METEORE stalked between horses then a bit off the rail on the second turn, found the inside into the stretch, bid along the fence past midstretch and continued willingly but was outfinished. OIL MAN (IRE) allowed to settle outside

a rival then three deep into the second turn, continued outside into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. GRETSKY four wide in the chute, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PAPA CLEM pulled his way along to stalk

outside then alongside a rival, bid outside the pacesetter on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the final furlong. MIDNIGHT MISCHIEF bumped and steadied in tight in the chute, saved ground, steadied off heels early on the second turn, came out on that turn and was not a threat. AFLEET EAGLE angled in early then came out into the first turn, angled in again and stalked inside, fell back some nearing the second turn, was pulled up early on that turn and vanned off.
