second turn, came off the inside in the stretch, battled back just off the fence and continued gamely to the wire. EXTENSIVE stalked the pace outside a rival or off the rail, bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn, fought back between horses through the final furlong and also went willingly to the end. CLOUD MAN chased off the rail then angled in on the first turn, came out on the backstretch, swung four wide into the stretch and finished well. AKKADIAN broke a bit awkwardly, stalked the pace inside, bid along the rail in the final furlong and was outfinished. DREAMY KID settled off the rail, steadied and came out behind BURNS nearing the first turn, swung five wide into the stretch and could not

quite summon the necessary late kick. LIL BIT O'FUN settled off the rail, also steadied and was forced out passing BURNS nearing the first

turn, angled in on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. THIRTYFIRSTSTREET dueled outside the runner-up then between horses on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch, then weakened. BURNS wide in the chute, angled in and settled off the rail then broke down nearing the first turn.
