1 1/2 MILES. (Turf) (1.443) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 *DEL MAR DERBY (GRADE II) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS*. By subscription of \$300 each, which shall accompany the nomination, or by supplementary nomination of \$2,500 each by closing time of entries, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,750 additional to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to first, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. First preference will be given to graded or group stakes winners. Second preference will be given to horses which have finished second or third in graded or group stakes. Total non-claiming purse earnings will determine the order of preference for horses of equal status. Entry fees will be refunded to all horses which fail to draw into this race. THE FIELD WILL BE DRAWN TO TEN WITH A MAXIMUM OF FOUR ALSO-ELIGIBLES BY THE CLOSING TIME OF ENTRIES, THURSDAY, AUGUST 29. Nominations closed, August 22, 2013 with 34. Supplementary nominations closed August 29, 2013 with 1. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Del Mar Derby divided into 2 divisions with a total of 24 entries including 1 supplementary entry. (Clear 81)

GABRIEL CHARLES angled in and chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, bid alongside a rival in midstretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, inched away under energetic handling and proved best. GERVINHO angled in and stalked the pace inside, moved up along the rail into the stretch, came out for room in midstretch and edged the pacesetter late for second. REDWOOD KITTEN sped to the early lead outside rivals, angled in and set the pace inside, battled along the rail on the second turn, came off the fence into the stretch, drifted inward in midstretch and held third. PROCUREMENT unhurried a bit off the rail early, went outside a rival on the backstretch, continued just off the fence on the second turn and into the stretch, found the inside in the drive and bested the others. OUTSIDE NASHVILLE saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. PURE LOYALTY stalked outside a rival, bid three deep into the second turn, dropped back some into the stretch and weakened. CHIEF HAVOC four wide leaving the chute, stalked outside a rival, bid between horses into and on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. SAY OW pulled along the inside and was in tight leaving the chute, came off the rail, went outside a rival then three deep or off the rail into and on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a response in the drive. RISING LEGEND (GB) pulled between horses then outside a rival on the first turn, came out and had the saddle slip forward into the backstretch, went up three wide on the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. SI SAGE (FR) pulled along the inside and was in tight off heels in the chute, saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back into and on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
