1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.443) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 *DEL MAR DERBY (GRADE II) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS*. By subscription of \$300 each, which shall accompany the nomination, or by supplementary nomination of \$2,500 each by closing time of entries, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,750 additional to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to first, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. First preference will be given to graded or group stakes winners. Second preference will be given to horses which have finished second or third in graded or group stakes. Total non-claiming purse earnings will determine the order of preference for horses of equal status. Entry fees will be refunded to all horses which fail to draw into this race. THE FIELD WILL BE DRAWN TO TEN WITH A MAXIMUM OF FOUR ALSO-ELIGIBLES BY THE CLOSING TIME OF ENTRIES, THURSDAY, AUGUST 29. Nominations closed Thursday, August 22, 2013 with 34. Supplementary nominations closed Thursday, August 29, 2013 with 1. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Del Mar Derby divided into 2 divisions, with a total of 24 entries including 1 supplementary entry. (Cloudy 81)

ETHNIC DANCE bobbed at the start, went up inside to gain the lead, set the pace along the inside, turned back a couple of bids from OLYMPIC BLUE on the backstretch and second turn, inched away a bit off the rail into the stretch, drifted in from the whip past midstretch and held on gamely under urging. INFINITE MAGIC saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and finished willingly between foes late. DEN'S LEGACY between foes early, stalked inside, came out slightly and steadied off the heels of the winner past midstretch and just held third. KID DREAMS three deep early, stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and finished with interest three deep on the line. GENERAL ELECTION pulled between horses then stalked outside a rival, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and was outfinished four wide between foes on the line. DORSETT three deep on the first turn, settled outside a rival then between foes into and on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and went on willingly five wide on the wire. DRY SUMMER chased a bit off the rail then inside into and on the second turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. OLYMPIC BLUE stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the winner midway on the backstretch and again leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. PLAY IT LOUD chased inside then between horses into and on the second turn and weakened in the drive. DICE FLAVOR pulled his way along four wide in the chute, chased outside, went three deep leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back and angled in on that turn and weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run between the first and third finishers but made no change when they ruled the latter contributed to his own trouble.
