OBVIOUSLY (IRE) a step slow to begin, tugged his way along outside a rival to take the lead on the first turn, angled in and set the pace inside, inched clear in the stretch and held on gamely under left handed urging. HE BE FIRE N ICE chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out past midstretch and continued willingly between horses late. SILENTIO between horses early, angled in and stalked inside then came off the rail with a move forward on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and also went on willingly three deep to the wire. EL COMMODORE sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside then stalked the winner, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, was between horses in midstretch and weakened. TIGAH (GB) came a bit off the rail then chased outside a rival, dropped back some on the second turn and did not rally.
