1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.443) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 DEL MAR OAKS (GRADE I) FOR FILLIES, THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$250 each, which shall accompany the nomination, with \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,750 additional to start, with \$250,000 guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to first, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. First preference will be given to graded or group stakes winners. Second preference will be given to fillies which have finished second or third in graded or group stakes. Total non-claiming purse earnings will determine the order of preference for fillies of equal status. Entry fees will be refunded to all fillies which fail to draw into this race. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday, August 11, 2011 with 19. (Rail at 7 feet). (Clear 75)

SUMMER SOIREE pulled her way along inside then stalked a bit off the rail, took the lead alongside a rival midway on the backstretch, kicked clear and angled in, opened up on the second turn and in the stretch and held gamely under urging. STAR BILLING saved ground chasing the pace, moved up into the stretch, came out in the drive and surged between foes late. NEREID stalked off the rail, went up three deep leaving the second turn, came out some in the stretch and finished well three wide on the line. CAMBINA (IRE) angled in outside a rival then settled inside, split horses into the stretch, came out in midstretch and finished well. CELESTIAL KITTEN chased a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn, came off the fence in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. ENTRUSTMENT saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the second turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. UP IN TIME (GB) angled in and stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and also could not offer the necessary response late. BIZZY CAROLINE settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. SINGAPORE LILLY (IRE) allowed to settle outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. DYNAMO angled in and took the lead outside the winner, inched away and angled in nearing the first turn, stalked that rival on the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back between foes into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
