INDESCRIBABLE stalked the pace on the outside, came four wide to make her bid, assumed command entering the stretch and edged clear. SERENADING was allowed to settle into stride, moved with the winner on the outside, was unable to reach INDESCRIBABLE but continued on well to hold the place. TEJIDA attended the pace along the inside, dropped back to last through the second turn, waited for room with three-sixteenths to run, angled out and was up with a rush to earn the show. MISS ISELLA angled in at once to save ground, launched her bid four wide leaving the second turn, but weakened during the drive and gave in. AWESOME ASHLEY set the pressured pace along the inside, opened clear after a half, was collared nearing the three-eighths pole, disputed the issue to the stretch and gave way. CROWN OF DIAMONDS prompted the pace two wide, but faltered from between horses after six furlongs and faded. DROP A LINE contended from between horses to the stretch and tired. SEFROUA saved ground to no avail.
