LUNAR SURGE was unhurried early, shifted into the three path in the far turn, angled to the rail in the stretch while making a bid, was blocked in with no room entering the eighth pole, finally got thru when clear and just missed at the wire. BLUE VIOLET pressed the pace early, took over command, angled off the rail into the far turn with a long drive in the stretch but did not have enough late. PRETTY FANCY lunged at the start and was back early, shifted into the three path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung in the late stages. TIZ WINDY tracked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch three wide and flattened out late. TWENTY IN ONE set the pace early, was on the inside into the far turn and gave way late. LIBERATED trailed the field throughout.
