1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.394) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *EDGEWOOD S. FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD*. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$4,500 at time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over on the turf, allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 at a mile or over on the turf since October 27, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Edgewood will be limited to fourteen(14). If more than (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Closed Wednesday, April 9, 2014 with 50 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Sixteenth mile.). (Clear 55)

Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Mar), by More Than Ready - Miss A. Bomb by Lemon Drop Kid. Trainer Matz R. Michael. Bred by William D. Gould(KY).

A LITTLE BIT SASSY, a bit rank when keen to go on early, settled entering the backstretch and tracked the leader under nice handling, bid to engage mid way on the final turn, dueled under solid hand urging from the head of the lane, poked a head in front in mid stretch, shook clear inside the sixteenth marker and was kept alert with a crack of the right stick. ISTANFORD broke outward and bumped with V V GOODNIGHT, straightened soon after and pulled her way clear nearing the first turn, dropped in to set a slow pace under rating, was joined by the winner after six furlongs, dueled on a slim advantage from the head of the lane to almost mid stretch, kept up the battle to the sixteenth marker, gave way grudgingly and saved the place. LITTLE JOURNEY (FR) came away in good order then was rank when being rated back off of rivals nearing the wire the first time, relaxed nearing the backstretch to stalk the pace, was put to a ride chasing between runners past the five sixteenths pole, continued under hardy encouragement into the stretch and leveled off nicely between rivals approaching the wire. V V GOODNIGHT, bumped at the break, angled in and settled well off the early pace, was guided out gathering momentum into the far turn, circled four to five wide making progress into the lane and kept on with interest to close the gap. GRANNY MC'S KITTEN was steadied along between rivals approaching the first turn, recovered and saved ground under rating, moved off the inside nearing the quarter pole, altered out to about the six path in upper stretch and finished willingly. COURAGEOUS JULIE saved ground stalking the pace, was under pressure pursuing the top pair into the lane but failed to go on. MISS MACHIAVELLI was steadied when put in close after a furlong, regrouped to save ground, was under a ride nearing the lane, angled out in upper stretch but could not muster up the needed kick. CANDY KITTY, three wide in range, edged closer under a ride after six furlongs, failed to sustain her run upon entering the stretch, faded and drifted out late despite right handed rousing. FONEPFERESH (IRE), three wide off the pace, moved out wider for the drive but failed to threaten.
