MILAM chased the pace early four wide, fanned into the six path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch from mid-track with a long drive late but did not have enough. CASH CONTROL pressed the pace two wide, shifted into the three

rail into the turn, gave way in the stretch drive while drifting out late.
