KERA'S KITTEN stayed on the inside and dueling for the lead, was well handled then drew off in upper stretch and was clearly best in the end. B'WANAGOLDMINE was unhurried early while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied three wide on the far turn and was making a strong move to be second best but was no match for the winner in the end. PRINCE EDDINGTON was well placed while racing three wide, rallied on the far turn but came up empty in the stretch drive. NOCKNONHEAVENSGATE was allowed to settle on the run down the backstretch while racing four wide, rallied on the far turn making a bid then flattened out in the drive. PERFECT LOU was in tight on the first turn and dropped back then stayed on the inside, started a run heading into the far turn and was checked off heels then saved ground and moved up the inside in the stretch while being no threat. MANKATO STRIKE was allowed to settle on the backstretch, made a mild rally while three wide on the far turn but was no menace in the stretch. MCKENNA'S JUSTICE was unhurried early then raced three wide on the backstretch, made a bid three wide on far turn the angled inside in upper stretch and flattened out in the drive. MAJESTIC VINTAGE was inside on the run down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. DANCE ALL THE WAY was unhurried early and failed to menace. DO YOU SEE ME NOW was hard to load then unhurried early and was no factor. DYNAISM duelled for the early lead while racing two wide, was hard used then gave way on the far turn.
