EFFINEX saved ground through the first turn before settling three wide in reserve just in behind the front, came under light coaxing near the

three-eighths, issued a bid three wide through the latter turn into prominence latched on to the top pair swinging four wide into upper stretch,

challenged the defiant pace setter a furlong out, dug in under a drive to wear down that stubborn foe knocking heads and gaining a slim lead inside the final sixteenth before inching a bit away gamely to the wire. RED RIFLE broke out a step at the start before establishing the front and crossing to the inside shortly after, showed the way in hand along the inside under attendance from WICKED STRONG to the outside, remained patiently handled coming under coaxing nearing the quarter pole as EFFINEX arrived on the scene, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under challenge stubbornly fending off that rival until inside the sixteenth marker, got headed inside that station while safely along for the place honors. WICKED STRONG brushed the off side stall at the start getting away last, bounded up to settle under rating to attend RED RIFLE from the two

path, remained in reserve until put to encouragement with five-sixteenths remaining, spun three wide between foes into upper stretch now joined by EFFINEX to the outside, dug in under a drive effectively shaken off a furlong out and made no late headway while well clear of the rest for the show honors. MICROMANAGE detached at the rear in the early going, saved ground through the first turn before racing three to four wide under prolonged coaxing five furlongs from home, angled seven wide into upper stretch under a drive and improved by tired foes in the lane. TURCO BRAVO (CHI) three wide through the first turn, settled three wide in range of the leader, came under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to

run, faded through the latter portion of the turn and swung five wide for home before tiring in the stretch. STORMIN MONARCHO tracked the pace from just off the inside under prolonged coaxing half a mile from home, angled three wide at the quarter pole, tired in the drive.
