By subscription of \$300 each on or before November 11, 2006 or by supplementary nomination of \$15,000 each by 12:00 noon (EST) Thursday, November 16, 2006. \$1,500 to pass the entry box; \$1,500 additional to start, with \$300,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, November 11, 2006 with 21 nominations. (Clear 45)

ERMINE gained a forward position inside early, was never far back, eased out four wide about the five-sixteenths pole, reached the front nearing the final furlong, then was under brisk urging to hold JOINT EFFORT safe. JOINT EFFORT pressed front-running SEA SIREN in hand three or four wide, reached the front just before going six furlongs, lost the edge to the winner from the outside at the eighth pole, then was coming again at the end. CURSORA (ARG) settled inside under rating, lost position and fell back last entering the far turn, remained along the inside to the stretch, eased out three or four wide for the drive and finished willingly. SUMMERLY hopped while breaking slowly, gained position between foes by the first turn, was never far back, eased out four wide leaving the second turn but was empty in the late going. SEA SIREN moved to the front early, briefly was clear between calls entering the backstretch, lost the advantage to JOINT EFFORT on the far turn, then slowly weakened. CRYPTOQUIP followed the pace within easy striking distance four wide for seven furlongs and flattened out. SANGRITA, a bit sluggish to begin, tucked in behind rivals nearing the first turn, raced four wide and eased out between foes on the backstretch, raced within striking distance for three-quarters and weakened. SILMARIL, four or five wide, tired on the far turn. A FOUL CLAIM LODGED BY THE RIDER OF JOINT EFFORT AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS DISALLOWED.
